

# Patricia Flanagan, MD

Dr. Patricia Flanagan is a pediatrician specializing in adolescent medicine. She is professor and senior vice-chair of Pediatrics at The W. Alpert Medical School at Brown University and Associate Pediatrician-in-Chief of Hasbro Children's Hospital.

Her research, clinical work and teaching have focused on the unique needs of pregnant and parenting youth and their children and on the role of social, family, and environmental influencers in child health. Pat directs The Teens with Tots Clinic at Hasbro Hospital, a multidisciplinary primary care program for teens and their children.

Dr. Flanagan is a co-director of RI PCMH-Kids, a state-wide multi-payer multi-provider initiative for payment/delivery reform and primary medical home practice transformation. This work has supported the transformation of pediatric practices to be family-centered, team-based, data-driven, and population-accountable. Currently more than half of RI's children and over 80% of RI's Medicaid-insured children are cared for by a PCMH-kids practice.
