She completed her Pediatric Residency and Neonatology Fellowship at Yale.

Having completed a master's degree in special education prior to medical training, Dr. Montgomery has a specific clinical and research interest in the long-term neurodevelopmental and neurobehavioral outcomes of at-risk infant populations.

Her research interests focus primarily on the impact of the NICU environment and various neonatal practices on at-risk infant outcomes and the early identification of autism in very low birth weight (VLBW) populations.
