I am a pediatrician who works in New Haven, CT and Chair of Advocacy for the CT-American Academy of Pediatrics Chapter which represents over 600 pediatricians in CT.

<u>One out of two families</u> in the US with young children experience diaper insecurity. Diaper need is associated with medical conditions such as <u>diaper dermatitis and urinary tract infections</u>. <u>The financial challenges</u> associated with diaper use is stressful for families and can lead to missed work (image). <u>One out of four parents</u> miss work or school due to diaper need. Further, diaper need has been to be associated with <u>maternal depression</u>.
